This panel will focus on identifying the best approaches and specific policy tools on tackling the confluence of the two authoritarian powers, China and Russia, in the information space. While the two countries have their own separate approaches to propaganda and disinformation and their strategies and tactics differ, they have also learned from each other and echoed each other's narratives targeting the Western countries. This trend has been highlighted by the Chinese reaction to the Russian invasion of Ukraine, which was followed by China's amplification of the Russian narratives on the war.
